Every company may submit a maximum of 3 samples for judging. However, only 1 sample may be registered each time under a sales name.

Judging criteria and their maximum number of points

Judging will be based on the DFV testing conditions (50-point scale):

1. External condition, condition of the container
2. Appearance, colour, composition
3. Consistency
4. Smell and taste

Assessment table for the individual type of sausage:

Gold	50 points
Silver	45 – 49 points
Bronze	40 – 44 points

Information on the collection of data according to Articles 13 and 14 of the GDPR
